Below is an excerpt from a book that has been a blessing to my life over many years. I had underlined this passage a long time ago and last week Ros was reading through the book and read it out to me. I felt it would be good to include it in this months' newsletter.

I pray it is a blessing to your life, **Ps Ivan.**

“Salvation is solely by grace through faith (Eph2:8) That truth is the biblical watershed for all we teach. But it means nothing if we begin with a misunderstanding of grace or a faulty definition of faith.

God's grace is not a static attribute whereby He passively accepts hardened, unrepentant sinners. Grace does not change a person's standing before God, yet leave his character untouched. Real grace is not the Christian's liberty to do precisely as he chooses. True grace, according to Scripture, teaches us to 'deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in this present age' (Titus2:12). Grace is the power of God to fulfil our New Covenant duties (cf 1 Cor 7:19), however inconsistently we obey at times. Clearly, grace does not grant permission to live in the flesh; it supplies power to live in the Spirit.

Faith, like grace, is not static. Saving faith is more than just understanding the facts and mentally acquiescing. It is inseparable from repentance, surrender, and a supernatural eagerness to obey. The Biblical concept of saving faith includes all those elements.”
